Labour Market Forecasting

Since the mid-1990's the Centre of Policy Studies has provided a briefing service on the outlook for the Australian labour market. The service has been supported by detailed eight-year forecasts of employment by industry, occupation, qualification, region, age and sex. Subscribers to the service have included several Commonwealth Government Departments, all the State Government agencies responsible for vocational education and training, and a smaller number of private sector organisations. Various researchers have contributed to the forecasts at different times, including P.B.Dixon, B.R.Parmenter, P.D.Adams, J.M.Horridge, J.A.Giesecke, F.Pang and J.M.Dixon. However, Dr. Meagher has been primarily responsible for preparing and presenting the briefing service during most of its existence. In recent years he has also contribuited to the labour market forecasts the prepared by the Institute for Employment Research at the University of Warwick on behalf of the European Centre for the Development of Vocational Training (Cedefop).
